**Subject: Harmful Construction Project**

Dear President,

This has reference to your email dated August 14, 2016 that you had sent to the members of the DPS Housing Society informing them about your proposal for the extended construction in the flats of our building.

Through this letter, we - the members of the Society - once again raise our strong objection to your intention for extended construction. Our objection is based on the following observations.












1. You had tried to start this construction project in 2015 also. But when the members of the Society approached the government with their objection, you had formally withdrawn this project in writing under the pressure from the government and genuine objections raised by the residents and members of the Society.
2. We remind you that the additional construction will weaken the existing building structure which can cause serious damage to life and property.
3. As per the Bureau of Indian Standards, Delhi lies in Zone-IV that has fairly high seismicity where the general occurrence of earthquakes is of 5-6 magnitude and occasionally of higher magnitude. Delhi lies among the high-risk areas. So, the additional construction will weaken our building which can suffer catastrophic damages in the event of an earthquake.
4. The construction work will also bring an enormous amount of noise and dust pollution in the building and will cause serious diseases to the residents - including men, women, and children. The National Green Tribunal (NGT) also prohibits such construction which is harmful to humans.
5. The proposed construction project that will run for years will be extremely disturbing for the elderly, sick, women, children, and students who stay at their homes.
6. This construction project cannot be considered even if one person's life is endangered. The truth is that the proposed construction will put to risk the lives of hundreds of people living in the Society besides causing damage to the property.
7. By the way, we are surprised and shocked to see your sudden motivation to carry out this "high-value" construction project while in June you (President and Vice President

of the Society) had admitted your inability to manage the Society's work and on June 5, 2016 you had formally expressed your decision in this regard.

With these observations, we advise you not to embark upon this misadventure and stop even thinking about the construction project which will only bring disaster for the residents - men, women, and children - of the Society.

You are also advised to stop using the Society funds for anything related to construction or otherwise, and stay within the monthly limits of expenditure as approved in the General Body Meeting (GBM).
